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# THE HISTORY

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The wine-growing history of Château La Vue began in the 16th century, during the reign of King François 1st.

In the 19th century, the lands of Château La Vue belonged to the owner of the Monolithic church of Saint-Emilion. It should be noted that this owner was making efforts to develop the vineyard.

1920-1957, the vineyard became the property of the Gombeau family. The house was then passed on to their daughter and her husband Eric Bordas. The couple devoted their time to improving the quality of the wine.

In 2013, seduced by the wine, the actress ZHAO Wei became the new owner. In order to produce a great wine, she appointed Mr. Hubert de Boüard as Consultant, to obtain the best expression of the terroir in the wine.





# THE CHATEAU

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Château La Vue owes its name to its location, below the hills of Saint-Emilion, with a view to the village.

The property, close to the most famous wine estates of the appellation, welcomes tourists in its shop, and offers for tasting and for sale the wines produced on its terroir as well as those from its different vineyards.

It also has an underground cellar. The head office of the wine trade company SAS Cellar Privilège is also located on the Château La Vue site. Among the wine offer, there is a selection of Bordeaux Grands Crus.



# THE VINEYARD

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Located at the foot of Saint-Emilion, this 15-hectare property faces the village.

Two grape varieties make up the vineyard of Château La Vue: 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. On gravel and sandy soils, this property produces two wines in the Saint-Emilion and Bordeaux Supérieur appellations.

## CHATEAU LA VUE

At 600 meters from the heart of the village, Château La Vue is located in Saint-Emilion. Close to the most famous crus of the appellation, its geographical situation, climate and soils together form an exceptional terroir to produce wines of excellent quality. On sandy loam soils, this property produces two cuvées on a 15-hectare vineyard.

**Production area:** 8 ha

**Average age of the vines:** 40 years

**Grape composition:** 90% Merlot  
10% Cabernet Franc

**Soils:** Sandy-loam

**Vinification:** In thermo-regulated  
stainless steel tanks

**Ageing:** 12-14 months

### Tasting notes:

Lovely aromas of wild strawberries are subtly combined with a fine oaky note. The mouth is balanced and harmonious, the tannic structure allows a good ageing.

## CHATEAU PATARABET

At 600 meters from the heart of the village, Château La Vue is located in Saint-Emilion. Close to the most famous crus of the appellation, its geographical situation, climate and soils together form an exceptional terroir to produce wines of excellent quality. This property produces two cuvées including Château Patarabet in Bordeaux Supérieur.



**Appellation:** AOC Bordeaux Supérieur

**Production area:** 7 ha

**Average age of the vines:** 40 years

**Grape composition:** 95% Merlot  
5% Cabernet Franc

**Soils:** Sandy-loam

**Vinification:** In thermo-regulated  
stainless steel tanks

**Ageing:** 12 months

### Tasting notes:

Deep ruby color. Intense nose of blackcurrant, blueberry, and some liquorice notes. In the mouth the wine is round, supple, silky, fresh, well-balanced and with a good length.
